Hospice Care

Hospice is provided for a person with a terminal illness whose doctor believes he or she has 6-12 months or less to live if the illness runs its natural course. Hospice provides comprehensive comfort care as well as support for the family. In hospice, a person chooses comfort care over curative care. Hospice services can be provided in the home or any other setting such as assisted living, nursing facilities or hospitals.

Hospice providers may help with:

- Skilled care through nurses, personal care assistance, social worker support, medications, equipment, and supplies.

Palliative Care

Palliative care is a resource for anyone living with a serious illness, such as heart failure, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, cancer, dementia, Parkinson's disease, and many others. Palliative care can be helpful at any stage of illness and is best provided from the point of diagnosis. Palliative care can be provided along with curative treatment and does not depend on prognosis. In addition to improving quality of life and helping with symptoms, palliative care can help patients understand their choices for medical treatment. Palliative care services are similar to those provided by Hospice.

Cost

Cost of services may be covered through:

- Medicare, Medicaid, private health insurance, Veteran benefits

Training and Regulation:

- Hospice & Palliative Care providers have training, certifications, and/or licensure specific to their profession and duties.
- Hospice and Palliative Care Agencies are licensed and regulated by the WI Department of Health Services Division of Quality Assurance.
